Initial Below	Once I become a certified Master Gardener, I further commit to:
	a. Use the knowledge I gain to educate the public on sound horticulture practices and do my best to accomplish the GCMG mission and goals.
	 b. Continue as an active member of the GCMGs by: 1. Performing a minimum of twenty (20) hours of volunteer service annually; 2. Attending at least ten (10) hours of approved continuing education annually; 3. Reporting volunteer hours in a timely manner (at least once a month before the end of each month); 4. Paying annual local dues, currently \$25.00, prorated (\$12.50) if certification occurs for a partial year; 5. Applying for and completing the Extension Volunteer Standards Course (EVS) and your personal background check every three vears, or as required by the Texas AgriLife Extension.
